

ISMND 2026 Abstract Submission Agreement

International Society for Molecular Neurodegeneration (ISMND)

Conference Theme: Cell Biology and Therapeutics in Neurodegenerative Diseases

Conference Dates: October 20–23, 2026

Location: Hong Kong

Submission of an abstract to ISMND 2026 constitutes a binding acknowledgment and acceptance of the following terms and conditions by the submitting author on behalf of all co-authors.

1. Scientific and Submission Standards

- Abstracts must present original experimental, computational, or theoretical findings relevant to neurodegenerative disease mechanisms.
- Abstracts describing commercial products must include scientifically valid, quantitative data.
- ISMND may request additional information to confirm scientific or ethical compliance.
- Acceptance does not constitute endorsement by ISMND.

2. Ethical and Regulatory Compliance

- Research must adhere to institutional, national, and international regulations for human subjects, animal research, biological materials, and biosafety.
- Authors are responsible for ensuring full ethical and regulatory compliance.

3. Accuracy and Scientific Communication

- Abstracts and presentations must accurately reflect data, methods, and conclusions.
- Authors must avoid overstating findings or implying unsupported clinical relevance.

4. Presentation Consistency Requirement

- Presented material must be substantively identical to the accepted abstract.
- Substitute presenters must be listed co-authors and require ISMND approval.

5. Authorship and Consent

- All authors must have made a meaningful scientific contribution.
- All co-authors must approve the abstract prior to submission.

6. Disclosure Requirements

- Presentations must disclose conflicts of interest, funding sources, and identities of referenced biological or proprietary materials.

7. Permission for Use of Name and Likeness

- Authors grant ISMND permission to use their names, affiliations, and professional likeness in conference-related materials.

8. Publication, Recording, and Distribution Rights

- Authors grant ISMND a one-time, worldwide, non-exclusive license to publish abstracts, record presentations, and distribute such recordings to registered conference attendees and ISMND members.

- Authors retain copyright to their work.

9. Indemnification

- Authors agree to indemnify ISMND and its partners against claims arising from copyright infringement, defamation, confidentiality violations, or other legal issues related to their materials.

10. Acceptance of Agreement

- Submission of an abstract constitutes full acceptance of this agreement by the submitting author on behalf of all co-authors.
